- ❖ **All sailors in Opti A, Opti B, Laser, 420, Sunfish A, Sunfish B & Sunfish C, need to be RIGGED AND READY TO SAIL by 8:30am or go home..**
Instructors have very busy days planned and unexcused lateness, without notification to Head Instructor will not be tolerated.
