BOAT RENTALS

In the past three years, our small sunfish rental business has supplied sunfish to lease customers on the river for their Jr. Sailors. These are usually first year sailors, when a family is not yet ready to commit to purchasing a full set of boat, dolly, sails, equipment and deal with the normal wear and tear (and frequent trips to Colie) without knowing at what level their child's interest will remain.

We predominantly lease Sunfish for the day, half days, or for full single weeks to summer cottage renters, but we also offer deeply discounted rates to Jr. Sailors for the full 8 weeks of program. Generally, this is both a service as well as the lease of an item, because we have multiple sunfish in our rental fleet. We offer single day turnaround on break/fix and no charge for the normal wear and tear that might be associated with the first year sailor's experiences. We will happily discuss this with any prospective clients, and have references from Beachwood Yacht club sailors (where we have rented boats for all 3 years we have been in business) as well as others .
